3. DESIGNATE 1 of 4-master degree tracks to pursue: Leadership, Ministry, Intercultural Studies (Church Planting), or Divinity
4. WRITE A PERSONAL ESSAY describing your spiritual journey, and how you will use this education to lead the church in *making disciples for Jesus Christ by serving individuals, communities, and the world*

The Master of Arts in Leadership and Master of Arts in Ministry degrees are customizable for Christian Methodist Episcopal students with academically qualified denominational subject matter experts and practitioners team-teaching alongside Asbury Theological Seminary faculty.

Courses are Hybrid 80% Online and 20% Onsite once per year at one of five sites. Minimum course load is 12-credit hours *per year* (2-courses per semester for all Master of Arts degrees).

Marjean Taylor-Myatt Ministerial Stipend and ATS Scholarships open additional options for persons from communities currently underrepresented and underserved with priority to increase by 20% the number of young adult CME clergy and laity earning accredited theological degrees, certification, and other credentials.
